SPECIAL EVENT REGULATIONS

These rules supplement the general rules of the Fédération Burkinabé de Golf and the association Golf club de Ouagadougou Naba GNINBOLBO. The conditions of these special regulations take precedence over those of the general regulations.

1- Conditions of participation

Professional players :

- Hold a current golf license a recognized golf federation.
- Be members of a recognized Professional Golfers' Association
- 60 professional players will be selected on a first-come, first-served basis.

Amateur players :

- Hold a current golf license a recognized golf federation.
- Meet the requirements of the Amateur Status Rules.
- Index < 25.5.
- Wild Cards: For players not meeting the above criteria, FBGOLF and SUNU have 20 wild-cards available for Ladies and Gentlemen.

2- Registration and entry

Registration is open until **May 10, 2025**. Please note that the first 120 registrations will be accepted. Register online at <https://fbgolf.bf/inscription> or via the QR code below:



Registration are :

- Professional player affiliated to FBGolf: 25,000 FCFA.
- Foreign professional player: 50,000 FCFA.
- Amateur player affiliated to FBGolf: 15,000 FCFA.
- Foreign amateur player: 30,000 FCFA.
- Caddy rate: 5,000 FCFA per round to be paid registration for the first two rounds.

By registering for the SUNU 2025 Open, players automatically agree to :

- Comply with the provisions stipulated in these rules, any other rules and any other decision drawn up by the Burkinabe Golf Federation.
- Accept that all administrative, disciplinary and arbitration matters relating to the SUNU 2025 Open will be settled by the Sports Commission of the Burkinabe Golf Federation in accordance with the present regulations.

3- Package

All forfeits must be notified to the Sports Commission of the Burkinabe Golf Federation before the start of the event.

In the case of a package notified by telephone, it must be confirmed in writing within 48 hours or immediately by e-mail to the following address: tournois@fbgolf.bf

If the forfeit is not notified, the player will be excluded from participating in the next edition.

The entry fee of any person withdrawing after the registration deadline will be retained by FBGolf.

4- Starting order and training

Training is forbidden from the 1st day of the event and will remain so until the official publication of the results:

- 1st offence: General penalty.
- 2nd offence: player disqualified for the remainder of event.

The SUNU 2025 Ouagadougou Open Organizing Committee will not communicate starting times by telephone. The final times to be taken into account will be posted on the official notice board the day before each round of the tournament.

Participating players must contact the Tournament Office directly to reserve their starting times for the training .

For amateur women, the provisional ranking will be established using the tie-break on the last round, then the 9, 6, 3 and last hole, then if the tie remains, hole by hole going backwards. The provisional ranking will be the final ranking, with the exception of 1st place in each amateur series.

1st place: If one or more competitors have the same score as the first-placed competitor, they will play as many holes as it takes to separate them. Only 1st place is eligible for the play-off.

The play-offs will take place :

- in "sudden death", according to the Stroke Play Rules;
- at the times and in the order of the holes set by the Event Committee and notified to competitors in front of the notice board.

It is the responsibility of the competitors concerned to be present at the start of the play-off. If for any reason the play-off cannot take place or is interrupted :

- They will not be carried over to the following day, and the provisional ranking will become the definitive ranking.
- Players already eliminated before the play-off is interrupted will remain so. Those still involved in the play-off will be decided by the provisional qualification ranking.

6- Bad weather and exceptional circumstances

Should the running of the 1st SUNU 2025 Open be disrupted by bad weather or any other exceptional circumstance, the following requirements must be met:

- A tour that has already begun should not be cancelled, but resumed or continued when conditions allow, even if this means postponing it until the following day.
- If it is impossible to postpone the conclusion of the round to the following day (last day of the event), the final ranking will be established by taking into account only the round(s) played in their entirety.

If at the end of this last , at least two rounds have not been played in their entirety, the 1st Ouagadougou Open will be cancelled.

If an interrupted lap cannot reasonably be completed on the last day of the event, then it will not be resumed.

7- Trophies and medals

The official SUNU Open 2025 Awards Ceremony will take place. May 17, 2025 for professionals and amateurs alike, at the gala dinner. All participants are cordially invited.

A prize of 10,000,000 FCFA (15,244.902 Euro) will be shared between the first eight (08) players.

"Procedures for the Committee" is edited by R&A Rules Limited effective January 2019.

APPENDICES

LOCAL RULES GOLF OUAGA

- 1 -Fairways are marked by small white stakes. The clubhouse area and driving range are off-limits.

- 2 - Carpeting is permitted on all fairways.

- 3 - A drop without penalty is permitted when your ball is in a gully (on the fairway).

- 4 -On hole 2, the dropping zone can be used if the ball lands in the plantations to the right of the green and in the flower bed in front of the green (without penalty).

- 5 -The inner limit between holes n.7 and n.8 only concerns hole n.7.

- 6 - On hole 14 the dropping zone can be used after 2 failures (Water).

- 7 -In a water obstacle, the player is not allowed to play his ball. He must drop the ball outside the obstacle with 1 penalty point.

- 8 -It is forbidden to use the carpet on the green. When the ball is stuck to the green and unplayable, the player has the option of placing the ball two grip lengths away.

The borders around the greens are considered fairways.

- 9 -A ball on the green can be replaced after it has been marked and removed from the green.
- 10 - On hole 7, the dropping zone can be used if the ball is in the water to the left of the driving range.
- 11- For trees on the fairway, the Drop is authorized at 2x club lengths in a semicircle without approaching, or backwards as far as possible in a straight line to the flag.
